All persons participating in the show in any way do so at their own risk. MHFSC will not accept any legal liability whatsoever for any loss or damage to property, including the transmission of any infectious disease to any animal. MHFSC will not accept legal liability for injuries to any person, except for death or personal injury arising from the negligence of MHFSC, its servants or agents.

MHFSC has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all persons on the show ground. All persons on the showground are expected to do the same and to comply with all instructions of Show Officials and Stewards

The showground is laid out so that competitors, horses and members of the public are kept apart. All persons attending the show must keep within designated areas.

By entry to the showground all persons agree to be photographed.

The onus is on every person who suffers an injury whilst on the showground, to report the fall / injury to the on-site First Aiders AND Show Secretary.

The maximum speed on the showground is 5MPH.

Many thanks for your valued support. I sincerely hope you enjoy the day and look forward to your continued attendance for many years to come.


